Play, share and take turns with other children.

Talk and listen to others.

Talk about the events in these stories, explaining how and why things happen.

Physical Development

Move with control in a range of ways, such as hopping, skipping and jumping.

Use a range of balls, beanbags, hoops and other equipment with increasing control.

Hold a pencil with good control and use it to form letters correctly.

Know how to stay fit and healthy.

Literacy

Talk about the characters, settings and events in a story.

Predict how stories might end.

Hear and say sounds in words and use these sounds to write words and sentences.

Blend sounds together to read words and sentences.

Use storybook language in our play and to tell our own stories.

Mathematics

Enjoy number games and number problems.

Recognise and use numerals to twenty.

Count objects accurately.

Solve simple addition and subtraction problems.

Talk about time, money, length, height and weight.

Play with, sort, name and describe a range of shapes.

Talk about our own past and present.

Understand that we can have different interests to our friends.

Use simple computer programs and technological devices.

Look at plants, objects and animals, comparing them and describing the changes we see.

Show interest and curiosity in the world around us.

Expressive Arts & Design

Learn a range of songs and dances.

Experiment and play with colours, sounds and textures.

Use resources such as cellotape, glue and scissors to create models.

Build and create using junk modeling resources, drawings, paintings, dance and role play.

Act out stories and role play games with friends.
