## Topic

You are stuck in Northern Europe and have to return by air to Abu Dhabi. Invent a flying machine out of any materials you wish to return home. You must build a model of the flying machine and accompany it with an A4 explanation sheet. Remember to use all of your "Materials" vocabulary words to help in your design. Good luck!

Design a treasure map of Neverland (A3 or A4) with a grid reference. You must give a detailed grid reference of where to find the treasure; where Peter and the Lost Boys live and where Captain Hook's pirate ship is. You must also include compass directions of how to get to the treasure from Peter's home.

Below is a map and aerial photograph of London.

1-Where do you think Peter and the other children flew to from here?

2-Imagine if Peter was alive today, how would his journey through London be different? What would he have to watch out for while flying?

3-You must help Peter on his journey and suggest 3 places from the map and aerial images of London that you think he would like to visit.

You must record your response to all 3 questions on an a4 page. If mentioning locations, say where they are on the map using compass directions

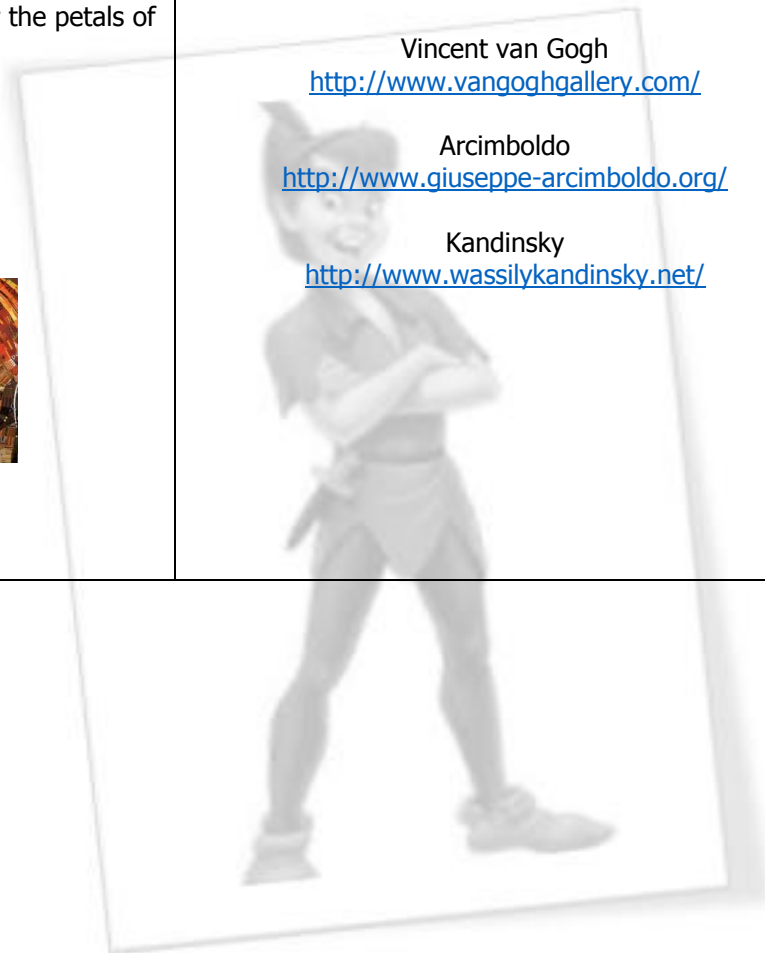
