Curricular Area	Option 1	Option 2	Option 3
Literacy	Research your favourite Polar region animal. Make a fact file about it.	Can you write a list of words that rhyme with cat, dog, day, cake, chain?	Imagine you are on an expedition to a Desert region. Write down at least 3 things you might need and why.
Mathematics	Make a video of yourself doing the 2, 5 or 10 times tables.	Roll a dice 3 times. Can you add the numbers together? Practise doing this 10 times.	Make up an addition or subtraction board game that you can play in class. Include instructions.
Topic	Go on a material hunt around your house. Can you draw and label the different materials that you find?	Design a seagull proof picnic basket using junk modelling- label it.	Create a poster showing the differences between hot and cold deserts.
Creative	Create a seaside scene using different materials.	Can you make cold snow? How does it feel? Name three countries you have been to (or would like to visit) where it snows. Why do you want to visit there?	Draw/design or make out of different materials, your ideal picnic food item that the Lighthouse Keeper might have for lunch. E.g. a wrap, sandwich, pizza, cupcakes, fruit salad etc.
