

<p>Maths</p>	<p>Famous number facts</p> <p>1) Look at this sequence: 1 2 3 5 8 Can you continue this sequence? This is a famous sequence - can you find out its name? Can you find any facts about this sequence?</p> <p>2) 6 is a 'perfect' number. Can you find out what a perfect number is? What is the next perfect number?</p>	<p>Measure</p> <p>Can you work out the area and perimeter of four rooms in your home? You can round your measurements to whole numbers. Can you draw a birds-eye-view map of the rooms to go with it?</p> 
<p>Art</p>	<p>Can you create a self-portrait in the style of Andy Warhol? Think about what colours you choose to use to best represent yourself.</p>	<p>Andy Warhol is one of the most famous pop artists, however, another famous pop artist is Roy Lichtenstein. Have a look on the internet/in books at some of his art. Can you produce a picture in his comic book style?</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>Research an inspirational person of your choice. Can you write a CV/fact file/biography about their life? Remember to make sure it is in chronological order; written in the third person and in the correct tense depending on whether you are writing about their past present or future.</p>	<p>Can you write a story to continue from this opening?</p> <p>I was bored looking around the dusty old market. I turned to leave when I caught site of a stand selling masks. Curious, I walked over and looked at the masks; wooden, metal, scary, funny, old. I picked one up and put it on my face. Then the world started to spin....</p>



<p>Science</p>	<p>Within Science we are looking at: 'Living things and their habitats', can you create a habitat for an animal of your choice. (The actual habitat does not have to be bought in, you can choose to bring a picture in). Be prepared to discuss and present your habitat.</p>	<p>Visit a Zoo with your family. Explore the different animal species you found there. Can you classify the animal species using the 'Linnaean Classification' system.</p> <p>You could choose to make a poster to describe what you found. Include drawings of the species that you saw in the different microhabitats. You may even want to create pie charts/graphs to show your findings.</p>
